Books

Through Storm you get a 10% discount on compulsory and additional reading requirements for your courses. Also, the books will be delivered to your house without additional costs. You can already find and order the compulsory course material for period 1 when clicking on your year and study, via the Storm page on the <u>Studystore webshop</u>.

Introduction Week 2020

Utrecht University as well as the Master Committee are working hard to come up with introduction activities that comply with the regulations concerning the COVID-19 virus. We understand that some of you might start the year online, and others might be living in Utrecht already. Therefore, our programme is largely online, and for the few offline activities there will

Programme

Utrecht University has made Teams for the orientation of both Water, Science and Management as well as Sustainable Development. You can join these Teams to stay up to date with the latest knowledge on the orientation programme.
