- Thrift Stores
 - o Clothing: Episode, Vintage Island, Kilo Kilo, Roxy 79
 - Furniture & more: De Arm (Oudegracht & Hoograven)
 - Check out Circle Hand Map
- Study Spots
 - Libraries: Center, Campus, Neude (less crowded)
 - o Buildings: Bolognalaan, Groenman, Langeveld
 - Cafés: Koffie Leute, Kaffeetaria, Stayokay Neude
- Parks & Other Greens
 - Amelisweerd
 - Botanical Gardens
 - Wilhelmina, Grift, Lepelenburg (good for borrels)
 - Paardenveld
- Sports
 - Olympos: has a gym and offers many sports, classes, activities
 - o Parnassos: relatively cheap dance & theatre classes
- Swimming
 - Kromme Rijn Zwembad: need subscription to use facilities (can join Hella's association to get in for free)
 - Public: De Munt, De Kromme Rijn, Down Under (small fee, but has beach)
- Bars
 - o Centre: Walden, Badabing, Lebowski, Oude Pothuys, Olivier
 - o Outside: Nijverheid, De Pomp, Klein Berlijn, Ping Pong Club



- Clubs
 - Dance Music & Hits: Poema, Gras van de Buren, De Vrienden, EKKO, Tivoli Vredenburg (Thursday & Friday sometimes free)
 - o Techno & Electronic: Basis, WAS, De Helling (sometimes), ACU (sometimes)

4. Culinary

- Restaurants
 - Quick & 'Cheap': Eazie, Last Vegas, SLA, FLFL, Poké Perfect
 - o Lunch & Dinner: Vegetalian, Karma Kebab, Anan, Gys
 - o Fancy Dinner: BROEI, Van Planten, SYR
- Cafés (can hold many different functions: meet-up spot, study location, COFFEE)
 - Keek, Kluts, Koffie Leute, Village Coffee, CUPP, De Ontdekking
- Bakeries
 - o Life's a peach

5. Activities

- Music
 - Jam sessions: Pothuys (Tuesdays & Thursdays), Bada Bing (every 2nd Sunday), Café Domkop (Wednesdays)
 - o Open mic: Pothuys (Sundays)
 - Rehearsal spaces: Musicspace (available 24/7 with lots of equipment), DB's (nice bar included)
 - Parnassos: offers fairly cheap music classes
 - University: student bands (big bands, choirs), Music Working Group Storm
- Tourist
 - Climb Dom tower
 - Canal tour with kayak or SUP
- Active
 - o Down Under: water ski & wakeboard
 - Vechtsebanen: ice skating
 - Karma Kebab: monthly roller skate disco and many other things
